

YAG LASER PROCEDURE

What is a YAG Laser procedure? A YAG laser procedure is used to break up scar tissue that can form after cataract surgery.

What to know about the YAG laser procedure:

- It is safe to eat, consume liquids and take medications normally prior • to and immediately after the procedure.
- The eye(s) will be dilated for the procedure.
- The procedure is done without any incisions to the eye. •
- The procedure takes only a few minutes and is entirely painless; nor does discomfort occur post-operatively.

You will receive post-operative instructions and expectations at the time of your visit, however you are able to resume normal activity immediately following the procedure.

A driver is not necessary unless you feel uncomfortable driving with dilated eyes.
