Glasses needed for near vision, maximizes distance vision.

Traditional Cataract Surgery

Monofocal Intraocular Lens - corrects vision at distance or near but not both. Will require glasses after surgery.

Utilize High Contrast Sensitivity Monofocal Lens, the Tecnis IOL
